2. Minutes of the previous meeting	
Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted.	
PS reported that since the last liaison meeting Hills and Dorset & Wiltshire Fire Rescue Service had held a meeting the outcome of which was extremely favourable and the intention is to offer training / presentations to DWFRS personnel where best practice and expertise can be shared so that both parties have a better understanding of how each party works and in particular when attending to fires at waste management facilities. Following the meeting DWFRS undertook a site audit and reported that the fire prevention systems and management plans on site are in good order.	
3. Update on site operations	
Site Operations PS confirmed that operations were running smoothly with no breakdowns or issues reported. PS confirmed that the plant operates 24/7 with systems running constantly. Environmental Compliance PS confirmed that no complaints regarding flies, odours or any other matter had been received at the site since the last meeting.
